Hello parents and carers,

Welcome to the end of Term 1.

What a busy term it has been. Our staff have been working extremely hard to implement the new Year 3 to 6 English and Mathematics Syllabuses. We are fortunate that we have a highly professional staff that have embraced this change and continue to provide outstanding support to all students.

Our students have had a very busy term participating in a range of sporting activities and continue to represent MPS extremely well, we are very proud of them all. Our Strategic Improvement Plan for 2024 focuses on 3 important aspects of education. Reading and Numeracy improvements are our main academic focus areas. The one area that is fundamental to improving these areas is Student Attendance, and this is our 3rd focus area.

Regular school attendance is imperative in ensuring our children have the best possible opportunity to experience positive life outcomes. It helps both academically and socially. We need your support to ensure your child gets the most out of their time at MPS.
